



## RUSTY MITTS TOURNAMENT MAJOR & MINOR OFFICIAL'S INFORMATION

### Officials

- 1) Officials will be Hockey Alberta certified referees
- 2) Minor Officials will be supplied by the teams. Please have your parents scheduled to assist in the box.

**Home team:** Scorekeeper and penalty box, **Away team:** Time clock and penalty box

- 3) All minor officials must be over 18 years of age.

If you play music, it must be clean and appropriate

### Scoresheets

- Scoresheets for games at Crowfoot, Crowchild and Cochrane Arena and will be in the penalty box.
- Totem 2 and 3 scoresheets will be picked up from the Tournament desk.
- Scorekeeper - Return game sheets into the desk at SLSFSC following games.
- If you game is at **Crowfoot or Crowchild OR Cochrane Arena**, TEXT 403-701-9290 the score as follows: **Age Group:\_\_\_ Game #\_\_\_ HOME #\_\_\_ AWAY#\_\_\_**
- If any major penalties or referee write ups, please take a picture and text them immediately.
- Bring the game sheet to once back in SLSFSC-Totem arena
- If any team wants a copy- please take a picture of it.

### Competition

This is an exhibition tournament. Depending on your age group, you will either play teams in a round robin only or if the schedule allows, you will play your 4<sup>th</sup> game based on your standings during the round robin play.

No prizes will be awarded.

### Format

- 1) Teams will play 4 games
- 2) Wins are worth 2 pts , Ties are worth 1 pt and a loss is worth 0 points.
- 3) All goals will be recorded on the game sheet, but the visible score card will not show a goal differential greater than 5 goals. (mercy rule).
- 4) If your **final** game is tied and there is time left in the ice time, please proceed to a shoot out.  
3 players per team, followed by 1:1.

**Rules of Play**

All games will follow Hockey Canada rules.

**2012-2010 Division Details:**

- 75 minute ice times
- 2 x 15 min + 1 x 20 minute periods
- 2 Referee System
- If there is more than 2 minutes left on the clock with 5 minutes remaining on the ice time, the clock will be dropped to 2 minutes.
- Floods in between games only

**2009 & 2008 Division Details:**

- 90 minute ice times
- 1 x 15 min + 2 x 20 minute periods
- 2 Referee System
- If there is more than 2 minutes left on the clock with 5 minutes remaining on the ice time, the clock will be dropped to 2 minutes.
- Floods in between games only

**Equipment**

- All requirements as per Hockey Canada Rules
- Team are to supply their own warm up & game pucks
